

LAKE OF ISLES

1 Clubhouse Drive North Stonington, CT 06359 • 1 hour away

Ranked one of the top golf facilities in the country, Lake of Isles has two 18-hole golf courses. The North Course stretches over 7,300 yards and offers daily-fee golfing. Adjacent to Foxwoods Resort Casino, golf packages including lodging, cart, range use, and optional spa add-on available. The all-inclusive fee includes 18 holes with cart, range balls, yardage card, and bottled water. Rates use dynamic pricing, so booking a tee time early will save you money. A Pro Shop is located at the facility. Matches Tavern is located at the facility, featuring views of the lake from the patio. Foxwoods also has additional dining options in the resort casino area. Memberships are available and necessary for access to the Rees Jones designed South Course. North Course Rating & Slope (Middle Tees): 71.5/135. South Course Rating & Slope (Middle Tees): 71.4/130.

ACUSHNET RIVER VALLEY GOLF COURSE – ACUSHNET, MA

85 Maine Street Acushnet, MA 02743 • 1 hour away

The 18-hole course offers up to 6,807 yards of playing. The front nine is built similar to Carolina golf courses and the back nine begins and closes in the woods, but is predominantly a link style design. Rates vary based on time and day. A same day replay discounted rate is available, as well as season passes. Tee times may be booked in advance. Rating & Slope (Middle Tees): 70.0/122

SWANSEA COUNTRY CLUB – SWANSEA, MA

299 Market Street, Swansea, Massachusetts 02777 • 40 minutes away

Open daily, Swansea Country Club prides itself on delivering top-notch service at competitive rates. This championship par-72 course is conveniently located just minutes from I-195, making it an ideal destination for your weekday or weekend golfing escape. Men's Gold Tees 73.5/Slope 128, Blue 71.5/Slope 125, White 69.9/Slope 123. Swansea Country Club's 9 hole Par 3 course was designed by Architect Michael Weremay and professionally constructed in 1999 by International Golf Construction. The course is an excellent place to improve your scoring or for beginners to learn to play the game. Couples love playing together in a relaxed environment.

GOOSE RUN GOLF COURSE

1 Naval Submarine Base Groton, CT 06349 • 1 hour away

Located on the North End of the base, this 9-hole golf course is open to military and DoD civilians. The course can be played as is, or run through twice to get the full 18 holes. A clubhouse accompanies the course and houses a pro shop, food and full service bar, and an outdoor deck with fantastic views of the river. A driving net is available to work on your swing and club and cart rentals are available. Frequent player cards are also available. The course is open April through November, weather permitting. No tee time is required. The nine-hole course is 2,466 yards, par 34.

NEWPORT NATIONAL GOLF CLUB

324 Mitchell's Lane Middletown, RI 02842 • 16 minutes away

This 18-hole course is open year round, weather permitting, and was recently rated the "Number One Public Access Course in New England". Golf architect Arthur Hills designed the 7,244 yard, links-style course, which features sloping fairways, marshes, and bunkers. Views of the surrounding water are in abundance, and winds from Narragansett Bay challenge you in the course. A Pro Shop and Bar & Grill complete the course, and clubs are available to rent from the shop. Prices vary depending on time, day, and season. If you're staying in the area, memberships are offered. Pro Golf lessons are also available, and can be done individually or in groups. Rating & slope (middle tees): 71.9/130.

GREEN VALLEY COUNTRY CLUB

371 Union Street Portsmouth, RI • 10 minutes away

An 18-hole, championship course measured 6,900 yards. Tee times can be booked in advance, including night golf. Prices range depending on time and day. A pro shop and bar & grill complete the course. Lessons and memberships are also available. A 200-person banquet hall, with dance floor & bar, is available for rent. Rating & slope (middle tees): 71.8/125.

JAMESTOWN GOLF COURSE

245 Conanicus Avenue Jamestown • 12 minutes away

A 9-hole public golf course is one of the oldest public courses in the country. It was designed and built in 1895 & opened in 1901. The course has rolling fairways and great driving areas, but will test your skills with well-manicured greens. The Caddy Shack has burgers, sandwiches, and a bar to relax after your game. Tee times are not required, but with a foursome can be reserved in advance. Rental clubs are available for a fee. Rating & slope: 69.7/110.

MEADOW BROOK – RICHMOND, RI

163 Kingstown Road Wyoming, RI 02898 • 40 minutes away

The longest public course in Rhode Island, it measures 7,400 yards and was designed by Roger Rulewich and Dave Fleury. No two holes are alike on this course and it challenges golfers with a Par 3 over water that stretches to 202 yards. This facility boasts a clubhouse with breakfast, lunch, and a full bar. A brick patio overlooks the course and golf carts are equipped with coolers. A pro shop is located at the facility. Rates vary by time and day, and walk or ride. Rating & slope (middle tees): 73.3/129.

HARBOR LIGHTS – WARWICK, RI

150 Gray Street Warwick, RI 02889 • 50 minutes away

A moderate length, 9-hole course. The facility is home to several dining options, an event hall, and a marina in addition to the golf course. Season passes are available. A pro shop is located on site, next to the Par & Tackle restaurant with a full bar and farm-to-table menu, featuring panoramic golf course and bay views. More casual dining is available poolside at the Tiki Truck, with a full bar and restaurant menu. Private lessons are offered with golf pros. Tee times can be booked in advance. Rating & slope (middle tees): 66.3/116.

PRIVATE CLUBS AND COURSES

There are many private clubs and courses located in the area, with several options on Aquidneck Island.
